

MEMORANDUM OF AMENDMENT AND MODIFICATION made this 30<sup>th</sup> day of August 2001

WHEREBY the following amends and modifies the Memorandum of Agreement dated 14 November 2000 between Blackwell Publishers, Inc. and the International Council for Small Business and the West Virginia University Research Corporation on behalf of West Virginia University as follows:

Clause 31 shall be amended to read:

The Publishers shall maintain stocks of and sell the current and previous two volumes of the Journal. The cost of transfer of a quantity (to be determined by the Publishers) of copies of back issues of the Journal from the Corporation to the Publishers' warehouse will be paid by the Publishers to the Corporation. The Publishers shall also compensate the Corporation for the printing costs of the copies provided at a rate to be mutually agreed upon between the two parties. Revenue from such sales shall be treated as part of total revenue as defined in Clause 22. For volumes of the journal that are three years old or older, the publishers shall contract with a backstock agent who shall hold and sell stock in quantities to be determined by the Publishers and the agent. Revenue from such sales shall be treated as part of total revenue as defined in Clause 22. The cost of transferring stock to the agent shall be paid by the agent.
