2017 mid year ICSB Board meeting, Philadelphia January 19th

# ICSB initiative on humane entrepreneurship and sustainable growth

ICSB is working hard to bring to global attention to the importance of SMEs in our global economy. In addition to working with the UN, ICSB enjoys close relationships with the OECD, the World Bank Group, and other major international stakeholders.

- On April 7<sup>th</sup> in Seoul (South Korea), under the leadership of ICSB past president Ki-Chan Kim, the ICSB declaration on Human entrepreneurship is presented and signed by more than 200 policy makers, businessmen, and academic experts.
- UN Ministerial roundtable: At the 61st annual ICSB World Conference the week of June 13, 2016, ICSB convened a Small and medium-sized enterprise (SME) Ministerial Roundtable at the United Nations Headquarters. Seven distinguished ministers were in attendance from the United States, South Korea, Egypt, Indonesia, Kuwait, New Zealand, and Argentina.
- Thanks to an intense and hard follow up work performed by our I/O Director, several meetings with country representatives have been organized culminating in a request of institution of the UN SMEs Day, which will be advanced by the Argentinean Government, and supported by other countries such as Egypt, Finland, Indonesia, Malaysia, and United States. I wish to acknowledge the participation of Mrs. Contreras Sweet, SBA Administrator, to our ICSB-GW October conference and of Dr. Sarah Nasr, Egypt Minister of International Cooperation, to the Egypt Entrepreneurship Summit. In both occasion we received ample attention and support to our UN initiative.

### World conference

- The IO, alongside Stevens Institute of Technology, served as the host and managed conference and pre-conference events over 6 days, and 700 participants from over 40 different countries.
- 2017 Argentina is being planned with our partners, I/O and board are working closely with ICSB Argentina and SEPYMES. One visit in September (President and Executive Director), another one planned in the Spring.
- New bids received for 2019 and onwards from Egypt and Finland, manifestation of interest from South Africa

### ICSB participation and support to Affiliates events and activities

- Asian Council for Small business conference, an event attended by 1000 delegates that gave an incredible momentum to ICSB activities in Asia, including the creation of two new chapters (Bangladesh and Myanmar).
  - Myself and Dr. Sargent attended to represent ICSB, delivered keynote speeches and were both featured on Indonesia television and Newspaper.
  - ACSB conferences planned for 2017 (Myanmar) and 2018 (Japan), 2019 China (under discussion)
- the Red Pymes conference in Argentina
  - Myself and Dr. El Tarabishy attended to represent ICSB and delivered keynote speeches.

- helped ICSB to consolidate its presence in South American, through the consolidation of the Brazilian affiliate and the request of creations of new chapters in Uruguay and Colombia.
- At the same time the conference was instrumental for the organization of the 2017 global conference in Buenos Aires. Not coincidentally it is Argentina the country that has stepped up to present a motion to the UN assembly for the institution of a UN SME day.
- ICSB Mexico hosted its 2nd international conference between October 12-14, 2016, in Pachuca, Hidalgo, Mexico. It was a very successful event, in any respect, thanks to the organizing team of Francisco Velez, Blanca Garcia Hernandez and others. Alex DeNoble, delivered the opening keynote to an audience of several hundred people as a representative of the ICSB Board.
- Egypt Entrepreneurship Summit in El Gouna in November was a tremendous success as well. We were honored by the participation of the Egyptian Minister for International Cooperation, Her Excellency Dr. Sahar Nasr, and the organization of ICSB's affiliate in the Middle East, MCSBE. A local edition of the ICSB Academy was organized and attended by 100 students in conjunction with a social entrepreneurship business competition (Nawa)
- At the end of November, ICSB participated in the World Bank Youth Summit in Washington DC.
- In December an ICSB delegation (Drs. Sargeant, El Tarabishy, and Vuolla) attended the largest start-ups event in Europe (Slush) in Helsinki (Finland). Our current ICSB Senior Vice President for Development, joined HRH Prince Constantijn of the Netherlands at Slush in Helsinki, Finland to discuss what governments can do to enable the ideal growing environment for startups.
