Requirements:

Tarkenton Certificate in Entrepreneurship

Another online option for busy entrepreneurs, University of Georgia's Terry College of Business offers the Tarkenton Certificate via the Schoolology platform. In six modules (and about 100 hours), participants learn about: Principles of Entrepreneurship, planning, funding, customer acquisition, financial and legal, and operations.

Requirements:

- Course completion within a year.
- Hands on application assignments.

Cost: \$150 (limited access), \$175 (monthly payments), or \$850 for all course modules

Best for: Beginner entrepreneurs, early retirees, and sidepreneurs who want to gain a foundation of entrepreneurial education.

Daymond John Certificate in Entrepreneurship for Adults
